August 28th we had a fire drill in the morning. The biggest take away for you when the alarm sounds is:

- 1) **Stay where you are.** If you are in your apartment stay there and keep your apartment door closed.
- 2) **DO NOT call the main number.** Staff are busy with the emergency doing what they are trained to do.
- 3) **We are a shelter in place facility.** Our direction for evacuation/relocation will come from the Northfield Fire Department.

**If you see tenants in the parking lot, please do not drive into our parking lot. Park on the service street or 8th Street to approach our vestibule. We ask that you not stop to visit with any tenant who is outside; a social wave will suffice. Remember to maintain social distancing and you must be wearing a mask when coming onto our property.**

From the Nurse's Office,

It's hard to believe it is that time of the year again. We will provide the influenza vaccination for all tenants. Our plan is to partner up with the Rice County Public Health Department. Their nurses will provide this annual vaccination to all Millstream tenants. A Millstream RN will be contacting responsible parties for permission as needed. We will also take care of filling out all necessary Medicare paperwork. If you plan to have the vaccination elsewhere, please notify the nurse's office so we can remove you from our list. Stay tuned for the date of the clinic!
